The *Betty Brown Professionalism Scholarship* is available to current Indiana Association for Healthcare Quality members who desire to enrich their lives with a professional certification. The scholarship offers the registration fees for one member annually to take a review course and sit for a certification exam. The type of certification is flexible and can be selected by the candidate as long as the certification is related to the healthcare quality field and meets with the Board's approval, e.g., CPHQ, CPPS, and CJCP. The awardee will be announced each year at the annual InAHQ Educational Conference in late spring. The cost of the certification review course and certification exam will be expensed to the professional certification offering. The course and exam must be expensed with intent to complete within the calendar year of award. A follow-up is requested five years after receiving the award to inform Betty how the award benefitted the recipient.
