Presentations will be selected based on the need for the topic, and the speaker’s knowledge and expertise on the subject. The InAHQ Education team will make final selections of all presentations for Annual Conference Concurrent Sessions.

The 2019 Conference will feature keynote speakers. Additionally, concurrent breakout sessions will provide an opportunity for deeper explorations of topics, to a varied audience at different levels of professional maturity-Beginners; Intermediate and Advanced.

InAHQ is particularly interested in presentations that highlight successful multi-disciplinary collaborations, innovative concepts and projects, and emerging technology demonstrations. The goal is to provide the participants with the necessary information, tools, resources, and best practice models for improving health care quality in times of change.
